Summer Adventures Equipment and Gear Checklist

- High quality Rain Gear; Jacket and Pants, (we recommend Sitka Gear, Kuiu or similar)
- Warm Hat to cover ears
- Ball cap to block sun/rain from eyes
- Warm Gloves; Waterproof with liners if possible
- Calf-high Rubber Boots, (we recommend Muck Boots, Bogs, or Xtra-Tuff boots)
- Waist or Chest Waders with rubber-sole wading boots (we recommend Simms for Waders and Wading Boots - www.simmsfishing.com)
- 2 pair Thick Wool Socks
- 4-6 pair Light Liner socks (wicking material like "Capilene")
- Onboard Shoes (lightweight deck shoes with non-marking soles; Crocs, Tennis Shoes, Tevas, or Keens, etc.)
- Long underwear (1 set, good for chilly days)
- Regular underwear
- Lightweight wicking shirts, Long-sleeve and Short-sleeve
- Sweater/Hooded Sweatshirts/Jacket (Fleece and synthetics are preferred to wick moisture)
- Pants (Comfortable and quick-drying synthetics are ideal)
- Swimsuit (For a polar-plunge or the Hot Springs!)
- Water Bottle, optional (1-1.5 quart capacity)
- Camera (memory cards/batteries/charger)
- Binoculars
- Toiletry Kit/Personal Items
- Personal Medications/Prescriptions
- Sunglasses
- Reading/writing materials for relaxing onboard
- Freshwater Fishing Gear
 - Spin-casting Rod/Reel; 12-15 lb. test and/or Fly Rod/Reel 6-9 weight
 - 18-20 Lures, 1/2-1 oz spoons, Blue Fox Pixies, red/white DareDevils, Mepps spinners (all brightly colored, red/hot pink/chartreuse/orange/purple/yellow)
 - 20-30 Snap Swivels
 - 20-30 Flies, bright colored, sinking (not floating!) We can provide a kit onboard for local preference if desired at \$25-50 per kit, depending on size of kit.
 - Weight-forward, sinking tip Fly Line, 12-15 lb. test leader/tippet
 - Assortment of Lead Shot
 - Hemostat or small pliers for water-releasing Salmon, char, and Trout
